What is the Oxford AHSN?

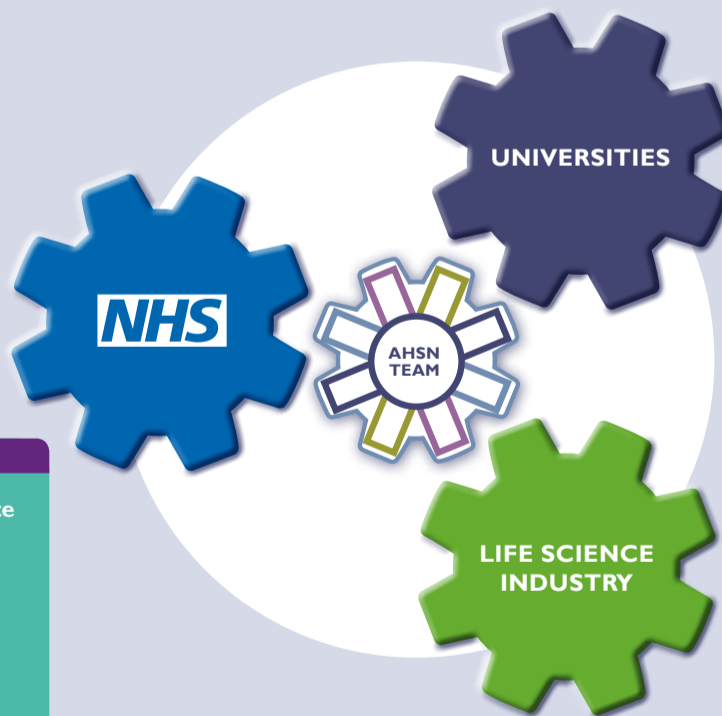

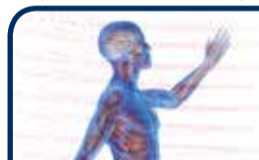
